Dear Mr. Mwangaguhunga:

We represent Andre Young, professionally known as Dr. Dre, in connection with potential litigation against you and your website, MediaTakeOut.com (the "Website"). A grossly libelous article was published on the Website on or about January 26, 2012, and is still posted on the website at <http://cdn.MediaTakeOut.com/53825/mto-world-exclusive-guess-which-music-super-mogul-is-getting-err-friendly-with-rihanna.html>. This letter serves as a formal demand that you post a correction, retraction and apology to our client for your defamatory statements on the Website that is at least as prominent as the article prior to its expected removal.

The following are the libelous statements contained in the article: that our client has a "new BUDDING 'friendship'" with Rihanna, that they were "kickin it at a top Los Angeles club earlier this week," that "the two BOTH got very drunk, and started hugging and being very FLIRTATIOUS," and that "[Dre] [brackets in original] was carrying on with that girl." Even the most cursory investigation would have revealed these offensive statements to be wildly inaccurate. Instead of responsibly publishing facts that have been verified in accordance with journalistic standards, the article falsely asserts our client of engaging in conduct that he did not and would not engage in.

In the absence of a prompt, conspicuous and meaningful correction of the record, our client will commence formal proceedings against MediaTakeOut.com LLC and you personally to obtain redress for the damages caused by your libel, along with punitive damages and costs of litigation.
